Basic Fjord Tour

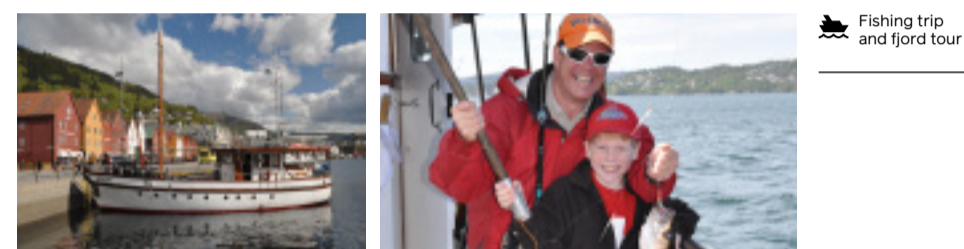

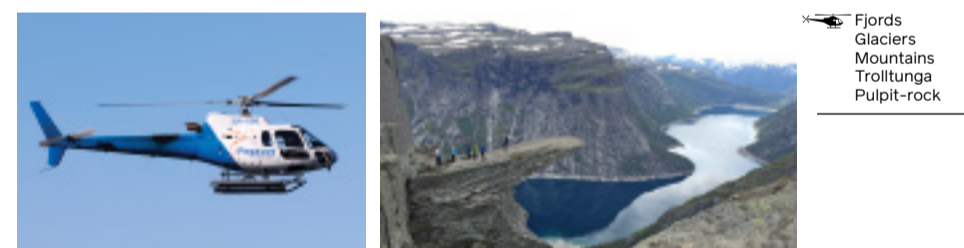

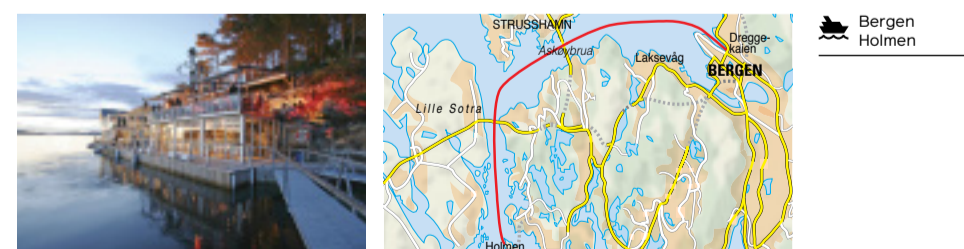

Indulge in a culinary journey

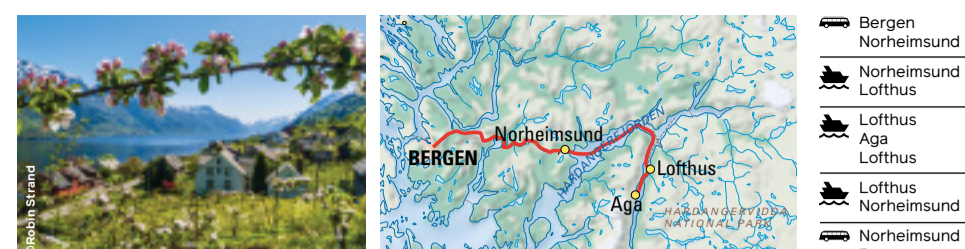

Hike the Icons: Trolltunga

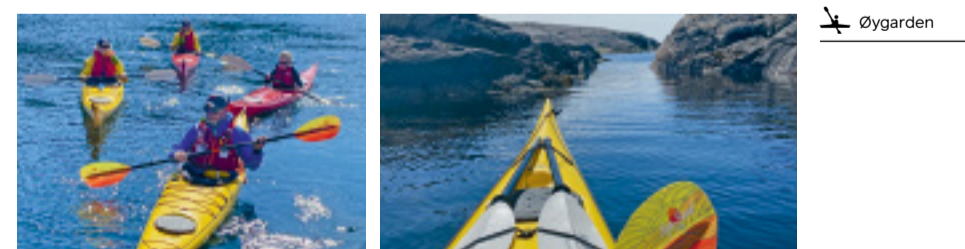

Return by bus and train from Odda to Bergen. This is a minimum 2 days round trip from Bergen.

WHAT IS A FJORD?

How were fjords created?

A fjord was formed when a glacier made a U-shaped valley by segregation through several ice ages. The valleys were then filled with water from the sea. The fjords can be long and quite deep and often surrounded by high mountains.

The deepest and longest fjords in Norway

The deepest fjord in Norway is the Sognefjord as it drops 1,308 metres below sea level! The Sognefjord is nicknamed the King of the Fjords and is also the longest fjord, measuring an impressive 205 kilometers.

The Sognefjord extends all the way from the Skjolden village in Norway's Luster municipality to the ocean. The Sognefjord has several smaller fjords branching out from it. The Nærøyfjord is the most famous of these. In 2005, UNESCO listed it as one of the world heritage sites, and The National Geographic Society consider it one of the premier world heritage sites.

Sognefjord is located north of Bergen, Norway's second largest city after the capital Oslo. Check out things to do in Bergen. The second longest fjord in Norway is the Hardangerfjord with 179 kilometers. The Hardangerfjord extends all the way from Odda in the mountainous interior of the country to the Atlantic Ocean. The Hardangerfjord is important to the Norwegians as one of the largest glaciers in the country, the Folgefonna glacier, is located along this fjord. The Hardanger region also produces about 40% of all fruits in Norway. Apart from its geographical significance, the Hardangerfjord is of great historical importance to Norway as it was the site of several historical settlements.

Are the fjords salt- or freshwater?

If the inlet of the fjord is connected to the ocean, the water in the fjord will be saltwater. The biggest fjords are all saltwater. Some inlets however are connected to a freshwater lake. If this is the case the water in the fjord will be freshwater.

Where does the word fjord come from?

Fjord is a Norwegian word that have become international, especially in English where it is used directly. Fjord comes from the Norse fjörðr. The word fjord was mostly used in the meaning "where one fares through", which has the same origin as the word "fare" (travel).

Can you swim in the fjords?

Yes, you can swim in the fjords. The sea temperature can be above 20 degrees in the summertime, perfect for a refreshing dip in the sea. Some places you will find beautiful sandy, white beaches, other places you'll have to do as the locals do; jump from the rocks into the water.

So, when is the best time to visit a fjord?

There's never a bad time to go on a fjord cruise. Get ready to explore the adventure of fjords and mountains.

Island Hopping Bulandet and Værlandet



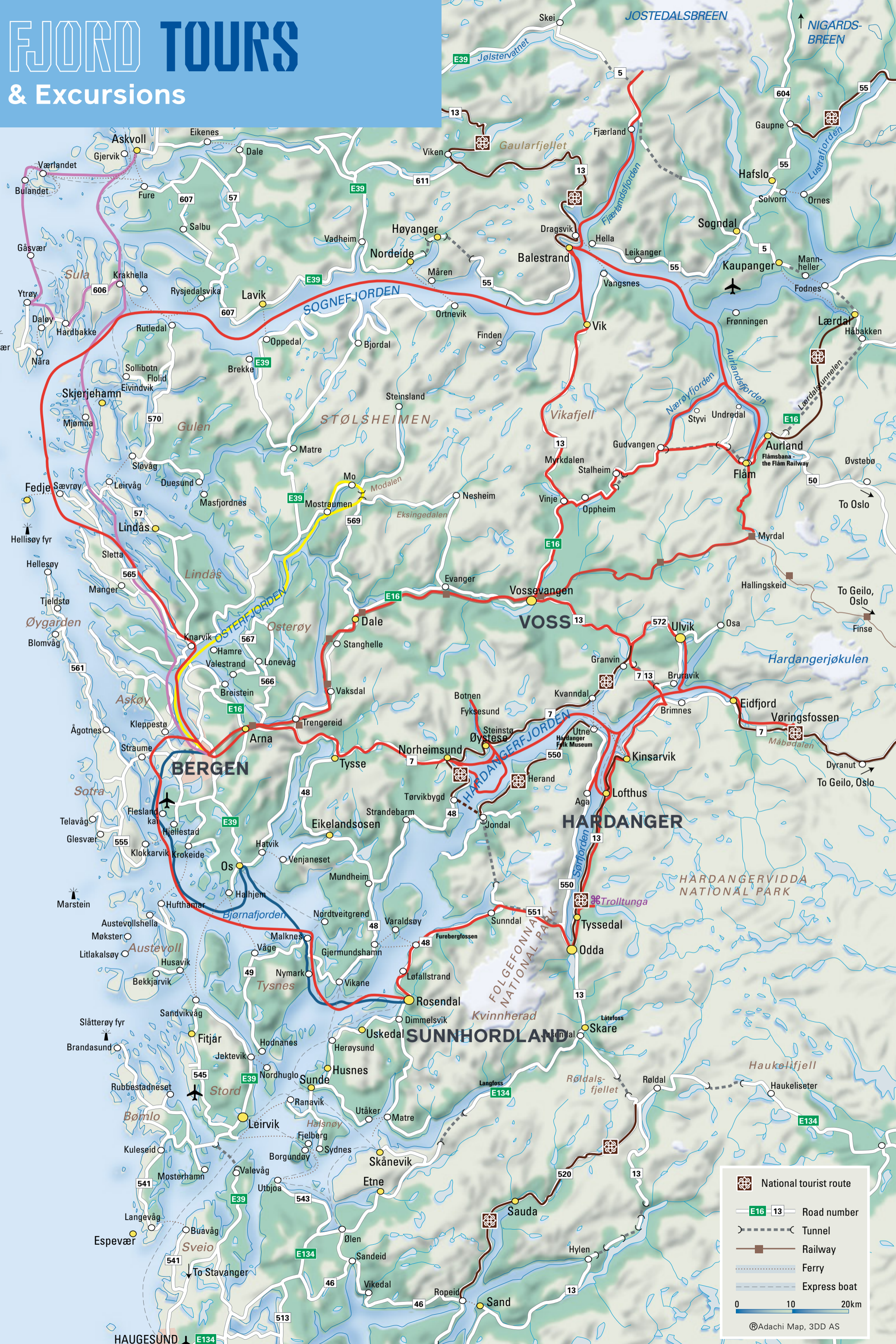

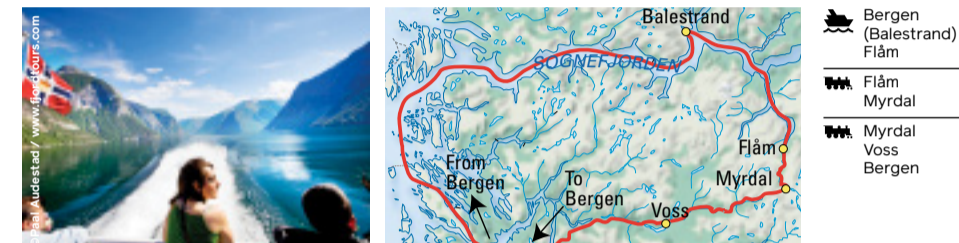

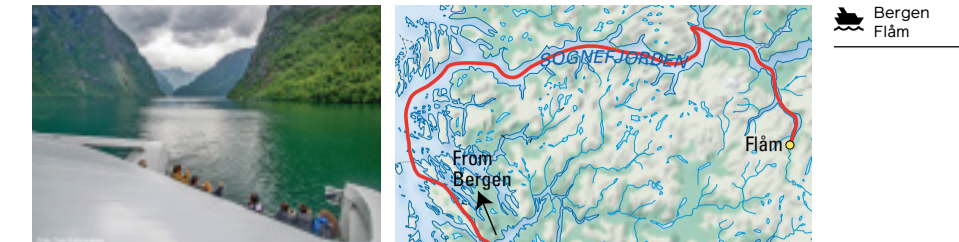

Bergen Fjord Cruise to Alversund Streams

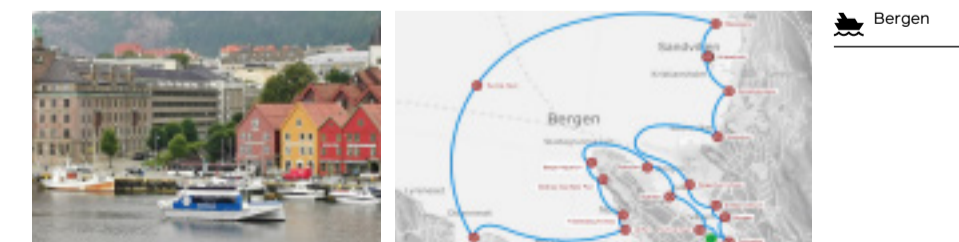
